I believe that Allah is the only true God.

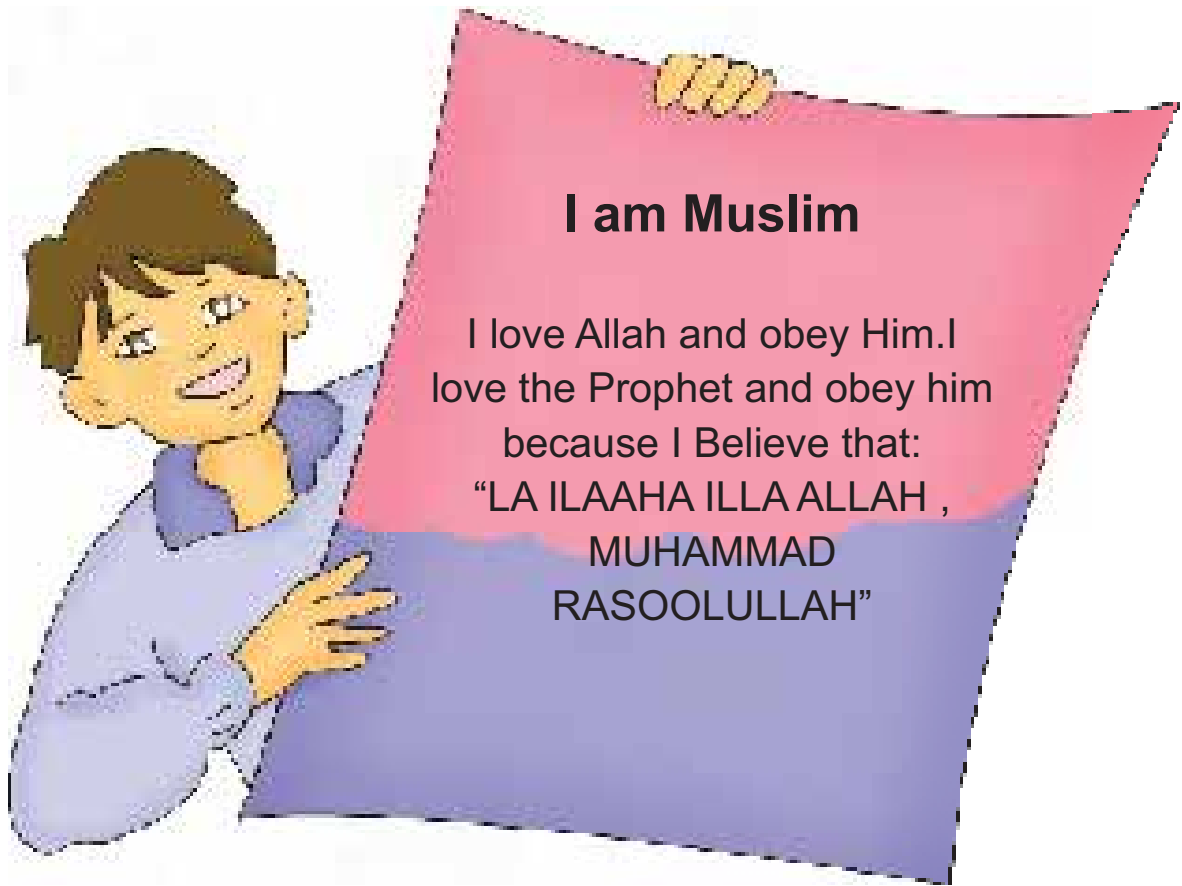

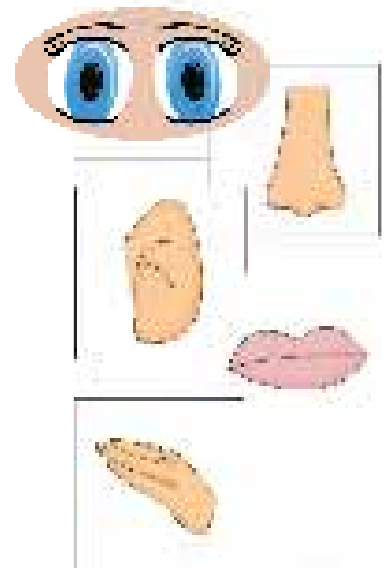

He used to go to a **cave** in a **mountain** called **Hiraa** for **one month** each **year** in order to **think** about **the one who has created this world**.

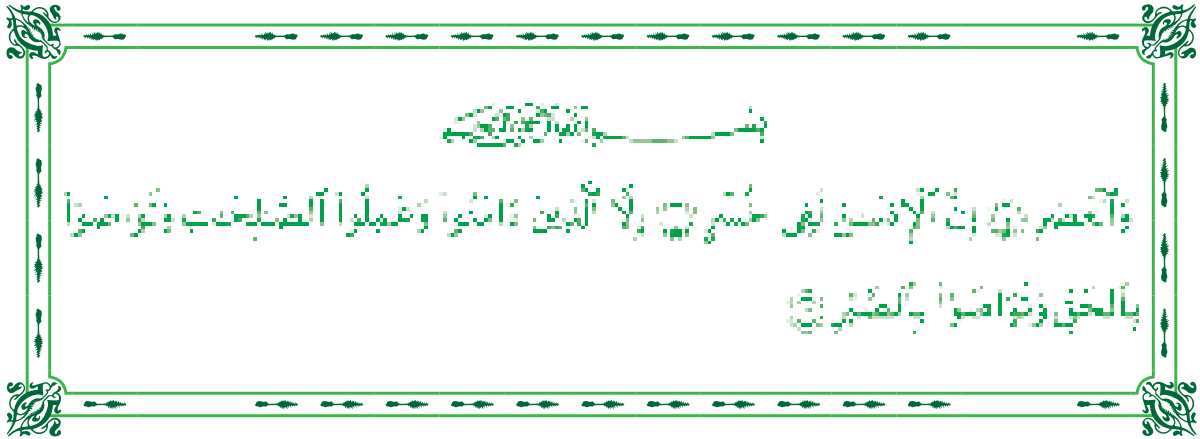

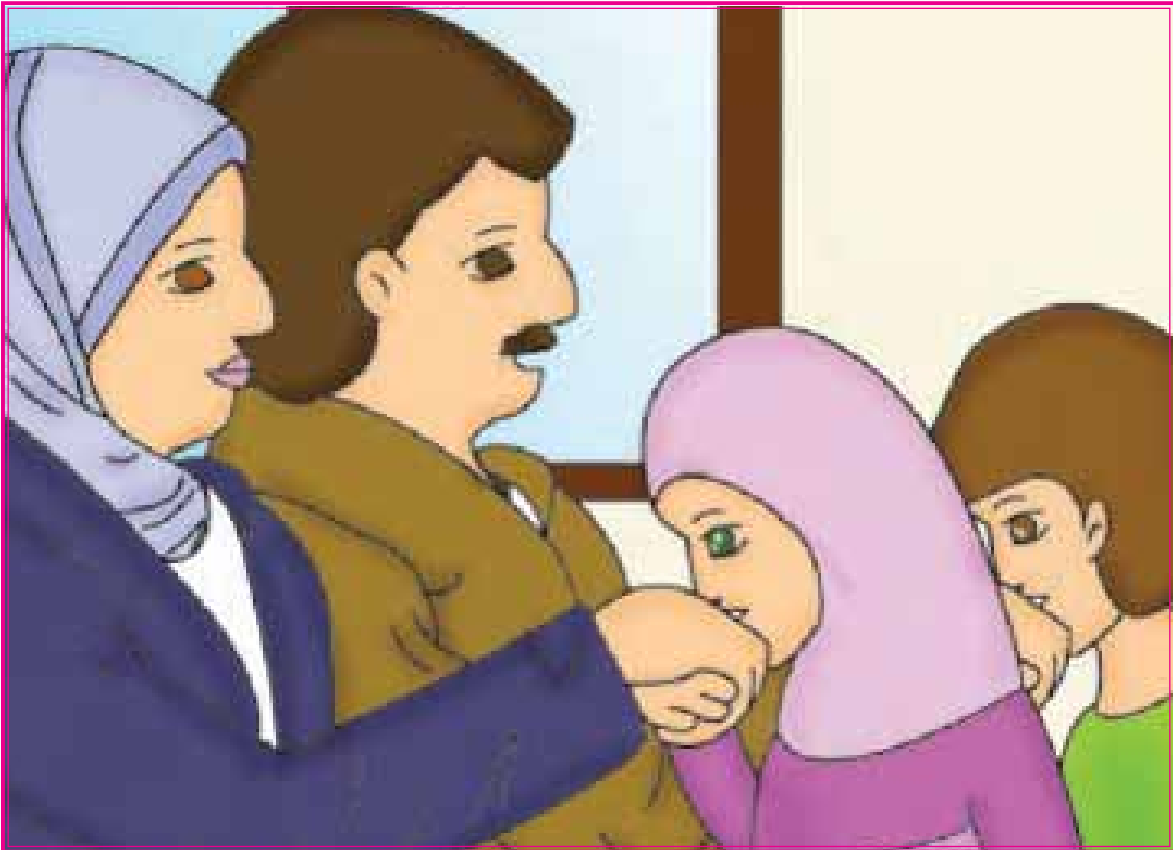

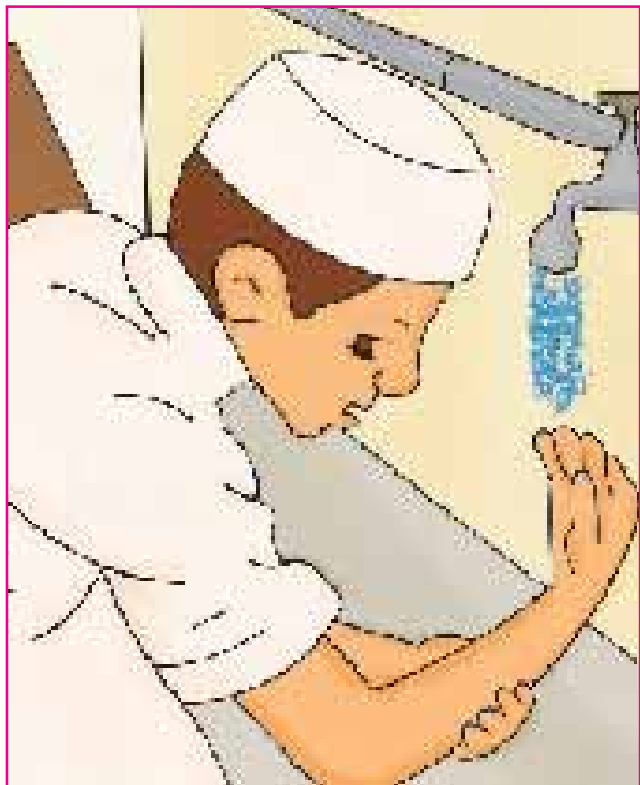
