

## The Five Pillars of Islam

1- Shahadah

2- Salah

3- Zakaah

## Read:


- Allah wants us to give charity to the poor.



4- Sawmu Ramadan

## Read:

- Allah wants us not to eat or drink during the holy month of Ramadan.



5- Hajj

#### Read:

Hajj is the fifth pillar of Islam. Hajj means a pilgrimage to Makkah during the month of Dhu al-Hijja; at least once in a lifetime for those who are physically and financially able to perform it.

# Aqeedah What Allah Wants from Muslims (1)






## Read:

Ashadu an la ilaha illa Allah wa Ashadu anna Muhammadan abduhu wa rasuluh.




#### Learn:

Muslims say Shahadah with their mouths. Muslims believe in Shahadah in their hearts.






## What Allah Wants from Muslims (2)

Each period for prayer has a special time .These essential times are:


- After first light and before sunrise (Fajr)
- Between the sun reaching its height and mid-afternoon (Dhuhr)
- Between mid-afternoon and sunset (Asr)
- After the sun has finished setting ( Maghrib )
- In the dark of the night (Isha)









## The building of the Kaabah



**Seerah** is the story of the Prophet and the people who lived with him.


Seerah tells us about the life of Prophet Mohammed.


# The Prophet Childhood (1)



The Prophet Mohammed was born in Makkah.

## Sallallahu 'alayhee wa selem

He was born on the 12th Rabi al-Awal, more than 1400 years ago.


